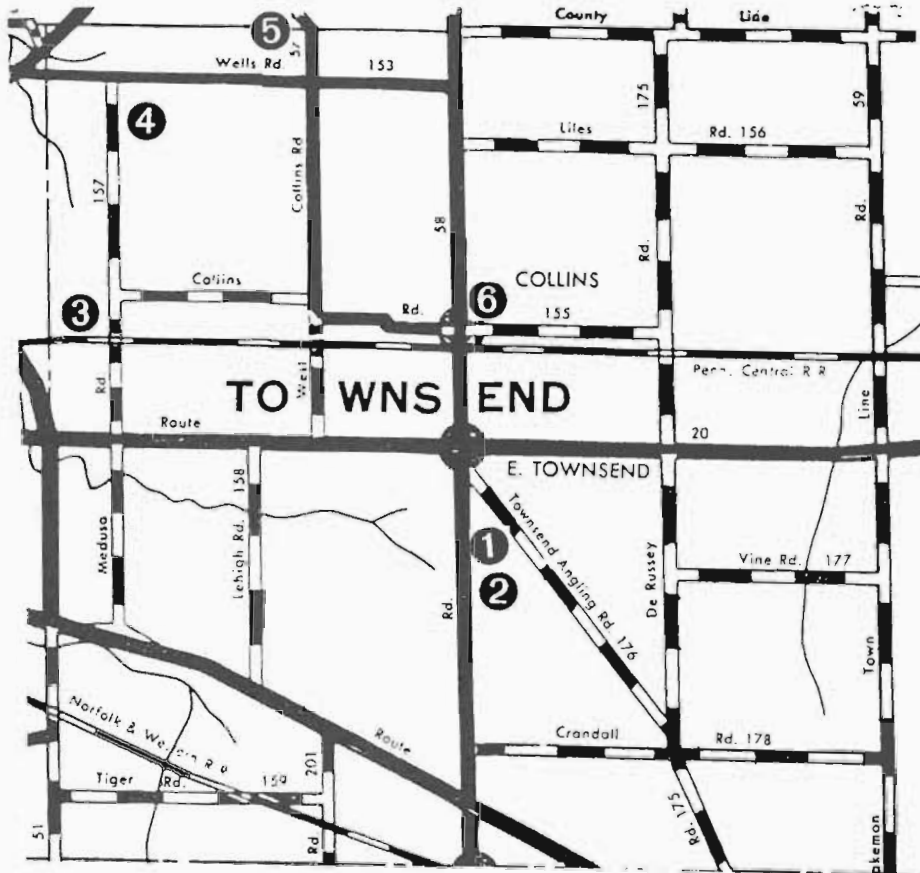

Townsend Center Cemetery

Townsend Center Cemetery is located in Sect. 1, Twp. 4, Range 21, Townsend Twp., on Angling Road a short distance southeast of Hartland Center Road at East Townsend. The cemetery was read in Nov 1960 by Henry R. Timman, by Russ Wilhelm in 1991, and by Marie Hohler and Mary Carabin in Oct 1994. Stones were read from east to west, right to left.
