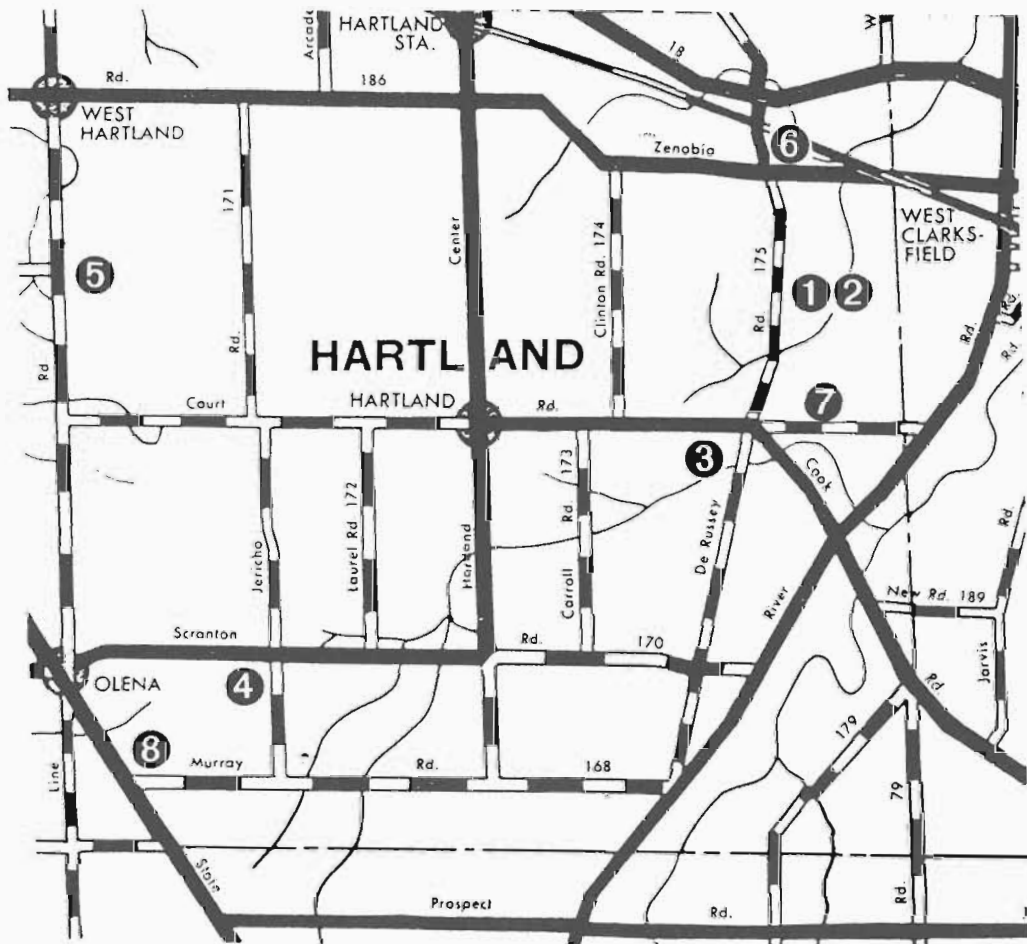

HARTLAND RIDGE CEMETERY

Hartland Ridge Cemetery is located in Range S2, T3, R21 on the east side of DeRussey Road, 1 mile south of State Route 18. The cemetery was read by Nona and Gene Funk, 1990 and by Mary Bick & Mary Carabin, Sept 1994. Due to the weathering of some of the stones, information from a 1964 reading by Henry Timman was occasionally used and is indicated with a note.

OLCOTT FARM CEMETERY, HARTLAND TOWNSHIP

The Olcott Farm Cemetery was located on Lot 14, S3, T3, R21, Hartland Township, on the east side of Greenwich-Milan Townline Road, opposite Union Road, 3 1/2 miles south of SR18. There were once tombstones in a barn owned by Robert Weisenberger, now in ruins. Henry R. Timman, County Historian, suggests that they may be for the OLCOTT children now buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, Norwalk.

TOLLS FARM CEMETERY, HARTLAND TOWNSHIP

The Tolls Farm Cemetery was located on Lot 17, S2, T3, R21, Hartland Township, on the east of DeRussey Road, 1/2 mile south of SR 18, and just south of the railroad bridge, at the Alta DeLapp farm. No marker remains. The History of the Firelands, Williams, 1879, p. 200, reads: "The first death was that of Jared Tolls, who died in the fall of 1818, from eating too freely of wild plums. He was buried on his farm, in a coffin made out of Daniel Bills' wagon-box, as there was no lumber to be had. A small apple tree sprout was planted at the head of the grave, which grew to be a large tree, but it has been removed, and the exact location of the grave is now unknown"

STORRS FARM CEMETERY, HARTLAND TOWNSHIP

Storrs Farm Cemetery is located in the northwest corner of lot 31, S2, T3, R21, Hartland Township, along the east side of DeRussey Road, about two miles south of SR18. The location is described in a deed from Daniel F. Storrs in 1859. He reserved the spot where his parents were buried. Mrs. Myrtle Pickworth was raised at the Ransom's, and she recalled about 1890 when Charley Ransom commented that they had plowed over the Storrs burials that day. The stones apparently do not survive except for that of one of the children which is said to be near the barn of Anne Fritz across the road. Information from Henry R.
