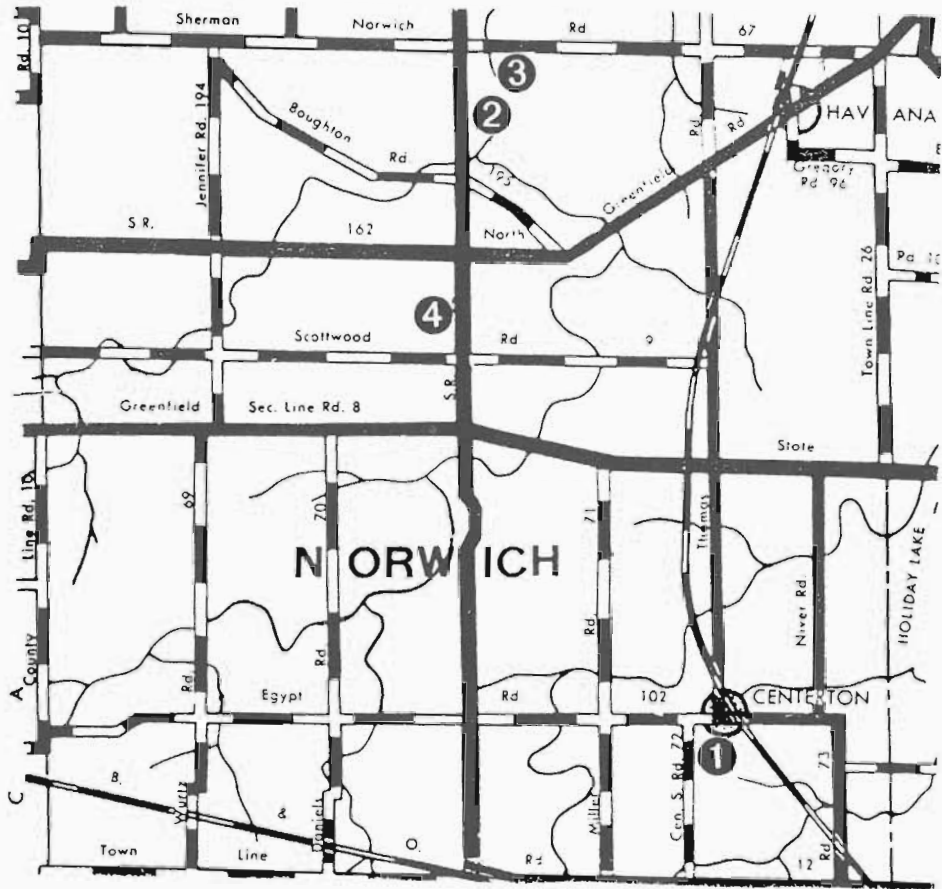

Centerton Cemetery

Centerton Cemetery is located on the east side of South Centerton Road, just south of Egypt Road and one mile north of Townline Road 21 in the village of Centerton, Norwich Township -- Range 24, Twp. 2, Sect. 1. The inscriptions given here were copied in Sept. 1987 by Ruth Reed and Mary Carabin. Sect. A is west of the drive, and Sect. B is east of the drive. Rows were copied north to south.

BANKS OF MUD RUN CEMETERY

The Banks of Mud Run Cemetery is located in Sect. 2, Twp. 2, Range 24, a few rods northeast of Boughton Cemetery, in Norwich Twp. It is noted in Williams' "History of Huron and Erie County," p. 422: "The first death was an infant son of Wilder LAWRENCE, February 19, 1817, only nine days after their arrival in the township. It [sic] was buried on the bank of Mud Run, some twenty rods northeast of the present burying ground. Soon after, Chauncey WOODRUFF, buried a son at the same place . . . The first adult person that died in the township was Richard MOON, in the fall of 1819. Elder J. Wheeler, then a resident of Greenfield, preached the funeral sermon. This was the first burial that had been attended with religious services. The body was interred on the bank of Mud Run." Also buried here were twin babies of Mr. and Mrs. Dickinson, born and died 24 Oct 1817 - "one

stillborn; other lived only few hours." Rev. Norman Bowen searched the area in 1992 and 1993 for this book and believes he found a spot on a bluff well above Mud Run that juts out quite a bit, and is a likely site for this cemetery, although no stone remains were found, if these ever were there.
